- This item was continued to be heard during the Regular City Council Meeting.

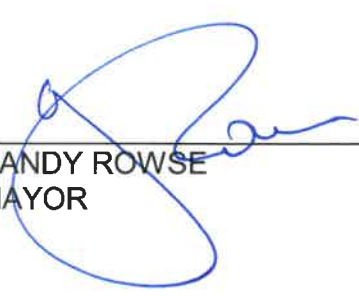
ADJOURNMENT
