## Discussion:

Finance Director Peirson provided revised estimates for the City's four major revenues of sales tax, property tax, transient occupancy tax, and utility users' tax, for the remainder of Fiscal Year 2009 and for Fiscal Year 2010. He also detailed a list of measures to close the projected deficit in the Fiscal Year 2010 General Fund budget, including a total departmental budget adjustment target of up to \$8,300,000. Figures to meet this target were given for each General Fund department under scenarios of 1) pro rata by budget; and 2) public safety departments would contribute 1/3 of the required savings, and all other departments would contribute the remaining 2/3 reductions. Finally, a list of potential options for balancing the General Fund budget was presented; these options are categorized as new or expanded fees or taxes (requiring voter approval), cost-cutting measures, revenue enhancement ideas, and citywide labor measures.
